MINUTES OF MEETING  
April 24, 2007

Treasurer's Report: Barb and Judy are working to get everything computerized. Financial Committee will meet soon. Checking balance to date is \$2,108.83.

Ron will check into possibility of having a show featuring Kathryn Crosby, wife of the late Bing Crosby.

Fred got City Council approval for the Roxy to be part of two weeks of ads, a \$1800 value. Discussion on radio ads, including giving away tickets. Brian made a motion we purchase a \$544 KMNT ad package which will run May through July. Seconded by Gretchen, and passed.

Discovery Tours will be visiting the Roxy for three shows.

Barb said the panels for the gallery have been ordered. Bonnie works 1:00 to 5:00 and perhaps the gallery could be open those hours.

Carl announced a \$2,000 grant from Transalta has been received! The children's theater ("On Stage") will present BUGSY MALONE this summer.

Gretchen reported from the Color Committee. Curtains (24 oz. velour) will be green like the metal on the Roxy seats. Back wall curtain will be black. Green formica for concession counters.

A letter needs to be written to the Masons, asking for the use of their building.

April on the marquee: bid package will be created. Meanwhile banners will have to do.

Other needs: handrails, nice garbage cans.
